

Global Aluminium market


- Growing demand for aluminium
- Projected 20Mt increase in new aluminium production in 10 years
- Requiring 40Mt increase in alumina production
- Meaning ~100Mt of new bauxite production within next 10 years

Existing Joint Ventures

- Bauxite Alumina Joint Venture (BAJV) with Yankuang Group
- HD Mining (Shandong # 1 Institute of Geology & Minerals Exploration)

Both JVs cover bauxite and alumina rights only BRL retains 100% other mineral rights





Bauxite Alumina Facts

- Darling Range, WA produces 23% of global alumina production
- 3 of 4 WA refineries are amongst lowest cost quartile
- Darling Range bauxite tri-hydrate cheaper to liberate alumina
- Existing Infrastructure to support new industry
- Skilled local labour force
- Established export routes



Before, during and after trial mining in northern Darling Range tenement area; three shipments exported to China totalling 128,647 tonnes at 49% Total Alumina, 40% Available Alumina & 2.3% Reactive Silica 11



BRL Other Minerals

- The southwest region of WA hosts:
 - Boddington gold mine (20Moz),
 - Collie coal field (2.4Bt),
 - Greenbushes lithium mine, and
 - Southdown magnetite project (scheduled for 2015).
- Most of the basement rock of interest lie under (thin) younger cover
- Limited modern (effective) exploration over region to date
- Free detailed aeromagnetic coverage released in 2012
- New magnetic data covers a large part of BRL's Darling Range tenement area
- BRL is currently generating new iron, coal and gold targets for review



- Potential asset quality across a range of tenements moving towards diversification
- Strong growth forecast in core bauxite/alumina JVs
 - Growing Bauxite resources
 - > 55% of tenement holdings now granted covering half of total tenement area
 - Agreements signed for exploration access to 566 properties (mainly farms)
